Keo City Council Meeting

October 24, 2022

Mayor White called the October 2022 meeting of the Keo City council to order at 7:00 PM. Those present were Mayor White, Recorder/Treasure Clara Hughes council members Lynda Staton, Randy Hudkins, David Lanehart and Chris Collins. There were 2 guests present.

Recorder/Treasure Clara Hughes presented the minutes from the September meeting after reading these minutes Staton made a motion to accept the minutes with a 2nd by Lanehart with all in agreement and the motion passed unanimously.

Financial Statement for the City of Keo September 2022 was reviewed by the city council. Collins made a motion to accept these financials with a 2nd by Staton and the motion passed with all in agreement.

Financial Statement for the City of Keo's Water & Sewer for September 2022 was reviewed by the council after looking these over Staton made a motion to accept these financials as presented with a 2nd by Lanehart with all in favor.

Fire Chief Joey Oliver presented a fire report and stated there had been 10 runs since July. He stated he had one volunteer resign. He then informed council that the rescue truck needed a large amount of repairs done. After a discussion on this matter the council voted to allow fire chief to sell the rescue truck in the amount of \$2000.00 and bring bids to next month's meeting to look into purchasing a new truck. The council gave the amount of 10,000-15,000 to possibly spend to purchase a new rescue vehicle.

Mayor White informed the council that the old swing set had been sold for \$200.00 and that it needed to be removed from the asset list. After the council discussed removing swing set from the asset list Lanehart made the motion with a 2nd by Staton & the motion passed with all in agreement.

Mayor White read the resignation from Jerry Morton and she wanted to thank him for all his years of service. She then wanted to remind that next month's meeting will be November 28, 2022.

Lanehart made a motion to adjourn the council meeting at 8:10 PM with a 2nd by Staton with all in agreement.
